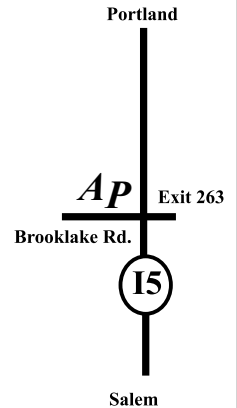

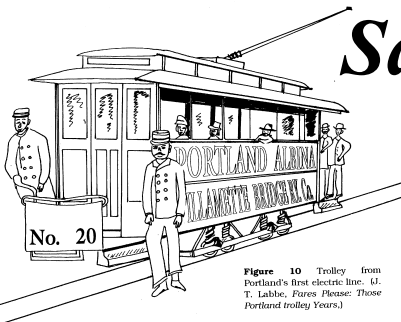
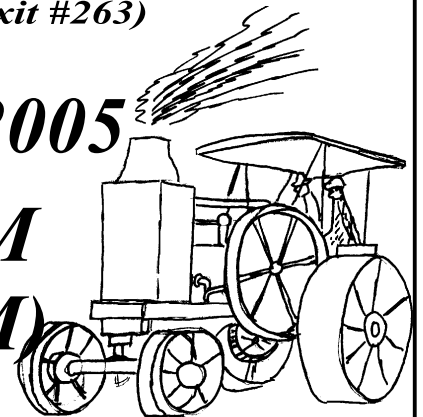


Figure 10 Trolley from Portland's first electric line. G. T. Labbe, Pares Please: Those Portland trolley Years.
