

Memorandum of Understanding
between
IEEE Oregon Section and Business Education Compact

This agreement formalizes a working relationship between the IEEE Oregon Section (“IEEE”) and Business Education Compact (“BEC”).

IEEE and BEC have a mutual interest in furthering the effectiveness of existing pre-college education, internship, mentoring and STEM career planning. Their collaboration may include, but is not limited to, these activities:

- Link to each other’s website
- E-mail members on relevant events and topics
- Support student and educator internships
- Support National Engineering Month
- Provide speakers at monthly meetings
- Share pre-college STEM best practices
- Provide newsletter or website content (articles)

The IEEE-BEC relationship is completely non-financial, with neither organization having actual or implied financial interest in the other organization. For IEEE, this is similar to “technical sponsorships” with other organizations.

This agreement only applies to IEEE’s Oregon Section organizational sub-unit and does not apply to any other IEEE organizational unit or IEEE at large.

The parameters of this agreement have been affirmed by vote of the IEEE Oregon Section Executive Committee.
